Variety description

Springscore is a powerful variety for spring crops in the traditional segment. The very high potential in production in pieces and kilo's is the most important characteristic. These productions have been seen the last years with different weather circumstances. Because of the single fruit setting Springscore has a fast grow out speed of the fruits. In the category 400-gram fruits you will not get very heavy fruits in this category. Springscore has to be grown in a generative way. 24-hour averages can be slightly higher than with other varieties and also leaves can be removed in an earlier stage. Two other important characteristics of Springscore are less dwarf growth and less black fruits compared to the main variety later in the crop. Springscore has an intermediate resistance against powdery mildew.
