## Description

Serein is a variety that distinguishes itself with its package of resistances to powdery mildew, CGMMV and CMV. It is a very productive plant suitable for high wire or umbrella cultivation. It is outperforming the standard variety in yield per pieces, but a slightly lower fruit weight. Serein is an open plant with small leaves and thin laterals, but this don't mean the plant is weak because it is very generative. We don't recommend to graft it. Fruits are long, with mainly 400gr to 500gr /pc. Color and quality are excellent.
