Description

Severance performed very positive among the different trials with a significant higher yield.

Severance is a strong, vigorous crop with generative secondary laterals. The variety has an intermediate resistance against powdery mildew. The variety is strong against CGMMV. The crop starts strong on its stem with a good transition towards the laterals. It easily creates length on its fruits making it easier to harvest heavier fruits if desired.

For a successful cultivation it is important to keep the crop open and hold a bigger day – night difference. The crop will be more selective and keeps its balance.

Severance is a cultivation sure variety which shows less abortion during extreme weather conditions or other cultivation problems.
